



## **Fine Arts and Science Team Registration/Informed Consent Form**

University of Illinois Extension will be providing 4-H educational activities and support for the students in this group. Participants will learn about a variety of different 4-H project areas, including development of important life skills. Extension staff, parents, and screened adult volunteers will lead these activities. Youth participants will be expected to:

- Arrive at designated times for the activities they would like to participate in.
- Be courteous and respect authority, property and others.
- Participate actively in the activities and stay in designated areas.
- Obey all the rules.
- Treat all people fairly and animals humanely.
- Use appropriate language and wear acceptable clothing.
- Show kindness to others and give assistance when needed.
- Be honest and honor commitments.
- Do their best and keep trying to improve and accept responsibility for their choices

**REGISTRATION INFORMATION:** State and federal laws require University of Illinois Extension to keep accurate records about the population we serve. The registration/informed consent form is required for your child's participation in these activities. These records are kept only by University of Illinois Extension and are not given to any other agencies or groups and are not subject to the Freedom of Information Act. Your information will be used for the following reasons:

- To keep accurate (confidential) records of the people we serve
- To keep you informed of upcoming events and opportunities
- To register your child for 4-H events and exhibitions (only with your consent)

Youth who are registered as members of the Fine Arts and Science Team are welcome to participate in any 4-H events and opportunities for their age group, including project workshops, youth conferences, 4-H Federation, Cloverbud activities, scholarship opportunities, and more.

**PHOTO/VIDEO RELEASE:** Occasionally we take photos and/or videos of our youth programs, which we would like to publish in local newspapers or other publications. We will not publish pictures of your child without a completed photo/video release (please see registration form). While we may also publish your child's name and hometown with the photo, we never give, sell, or loan our mailing list or other information to anyone. By signing the photo/video release, you give us permission to publish your child's photograph, name, and hometown, but please note that we will **NOT** publish or share information about your child's street address, telephone number, or birthdate without receiving further consent. A signed photo/video release is also needed to submit entries for the Illinois State Fair 4-H Performance Showcase.
